BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- God made people on Day 6 of creation.
- God created a man—Adam—and a woman—Eve.
- God put Adam and Eve in charge of the animals and gave them everything they needed.
- God created people in His own image, and He loves us.

KEY PASSAGE: Colossians 1:16b

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

• Who is God? God is our Creator and King.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- How do we know each and every person is important to God?
- How did God make us like Him? How are we different from God?
- How does God show His love for us?

- As you are out and about this week, make a game of people watching. Each time you see a person say, "That person is important to God."

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- God gave Adam and Eve one rule: they could eat from any tree in the garden, except for one.
- The serpent tricked Eve.
- Adam and Eve broke God's one rule.
- Everything was different after Adam and Eve sinned.

KEY PASSAGE: Colossians 1:16b

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

• Who is God? God is our Creator and King.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- How did the serpent trick Eve?
- How did sin change the world? How does sin affect us?
- Why is sin such a terrible thing?
- Whom did God send to fix our sin problem?

- List the rules in your household. Talk about how God's rules are for our good and our joy.
- Go on a walk as a family. Notice ways sin has affected the world, such as overgrown or dead plants, buildings or sidewalks in need of repair, litter, and so forth.

KEY PASSAGE: Colossians 1:16b

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

• Who is God? God is our Creator and King.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Why did God send a flood? Was God happy or sad to send a flood?
- What would you have done if God told you to build an ark?
- How is Jesus a better rescuer than Noah?

- Contact a relief agency that helps victims of natural disasters. Find out what your family can do to help and do it.
- Weather permitting, make a rainbow using a water hose and sunlight. Talk about God's promises as you experiment.

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

• Who is God? God is our Creator and King.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Why was God not happy that the people wanted to build a tower?
- Name a time you have tried to make yourself famous.
- What will happen when Jesus brings His people back together?

- Host a family competition to build the tallest block tower. Review the Bible story. Talk about doing all things for God's glory.
- Attend a worship service as a family in a language different than your own. Talk about what it will be like to hear people in every language worship Jesus together.

- How do we know God is good even when sad things happen?
